

Job Description for a Youth Minister for the Parish of Holy Trinity, Redhill

VISION

To see children and young people of Redhill, in increasing numbers, brought into a personal relationship with God, becoming fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

We wish to employ a church based full time youth minister to work with young people aged 11-18; and oversee the work of our children's ministry workers, in order to:

- ◆ Expand the current children and youth work at Holy Trinity
- ◆ Fully integrate young people into Holy Trinity by the age of 18
- ◆ Train leaders

PERSONAL ATTRIBUTES

- ◆ Agreement with our church statement of faith
- ◆ Ability to teach the bible one-to-one and in small groups
- ◆ Ability to motivate, lead, and encourage a team of volunteers
- ◆ Ability to engage in personal work with young people
- ◆ Ability to contribute to the overall leadership of the church
- ◆ Ability to be an advocate for children and young people on staff and PCC meetings
- ◆ Self-motivated
- ◆ In touch with and able to relate to contemporary youth culture

KEY ASPECTS OF THE ROLE

- ◆ To oversee, lead, and participate in the parish's work among young people aged 11-18
- ◆ To oversee the work of children's ministry in the parish
- ◆ Develop & implement a coherent strategy for the nurture of children and young people in the church
- ◆ Develop & implement a coherent strategy for outreach and evangelism among unchurched young people in the parish
- ◆ Encourage and lead a team of children's ministry and youth leaders and develop future leaders
- ◆ Develop and encourage attendance at summer camps
- ◆ To comply with all relevant safeguarding policies

It is envisaged that the distribution of time between children's ministry (ages 0-11) and youth ministry (ages 11-18) will be 20% and 80% respectively
